POST FALLS PARKS & RECREATION



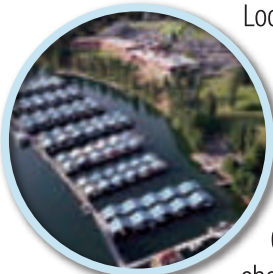

TIMBER PUB



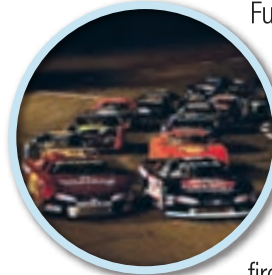

RED LION TEMPLINS



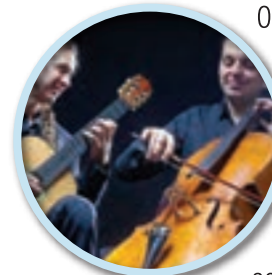

STATELINE STADIUM SPEEDWAY



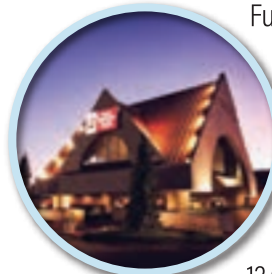

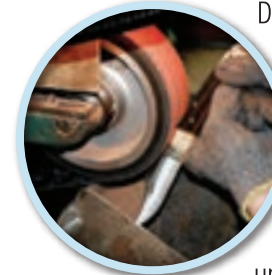

The rivers and lakes in the northern Idaho region are breathtaking. On the Spokane River, above the historic falls, is a mecca of adventure with miles of tranquil water providing boating, jet skiing, sailing, paddle boarding, canoeing, fishing... and more. Below the falls is a haven for kayakers and floaters. Towering Ponderosa pines continue down the gorge with high walls of rock faces to either side of the river create an enclosed world. It's intensely peaceful.



Hiking & Biking

Hiking enthusiasts have hundreds of trails and wilderness throughout northern Idaho. Every level of hiking ability will find abundant satisfaction from spectacular views of mountains, lakes and valleys, while exploring maintained trails in our community parks, national and state forests and backcountry lands.

The North Idaho Centennial Trail spans 24-miles from the Stateline through Post Falls and ending near Lake Coeur d'Alene where you might catch a glimpse of eagles nesting. Cycling around and through the region offers an unforgettable way to soak up the scenery. Plan a ride one of the most scenic "rails to trails" route in America, the Hiawatha Trail; family friendly for all ages.
