

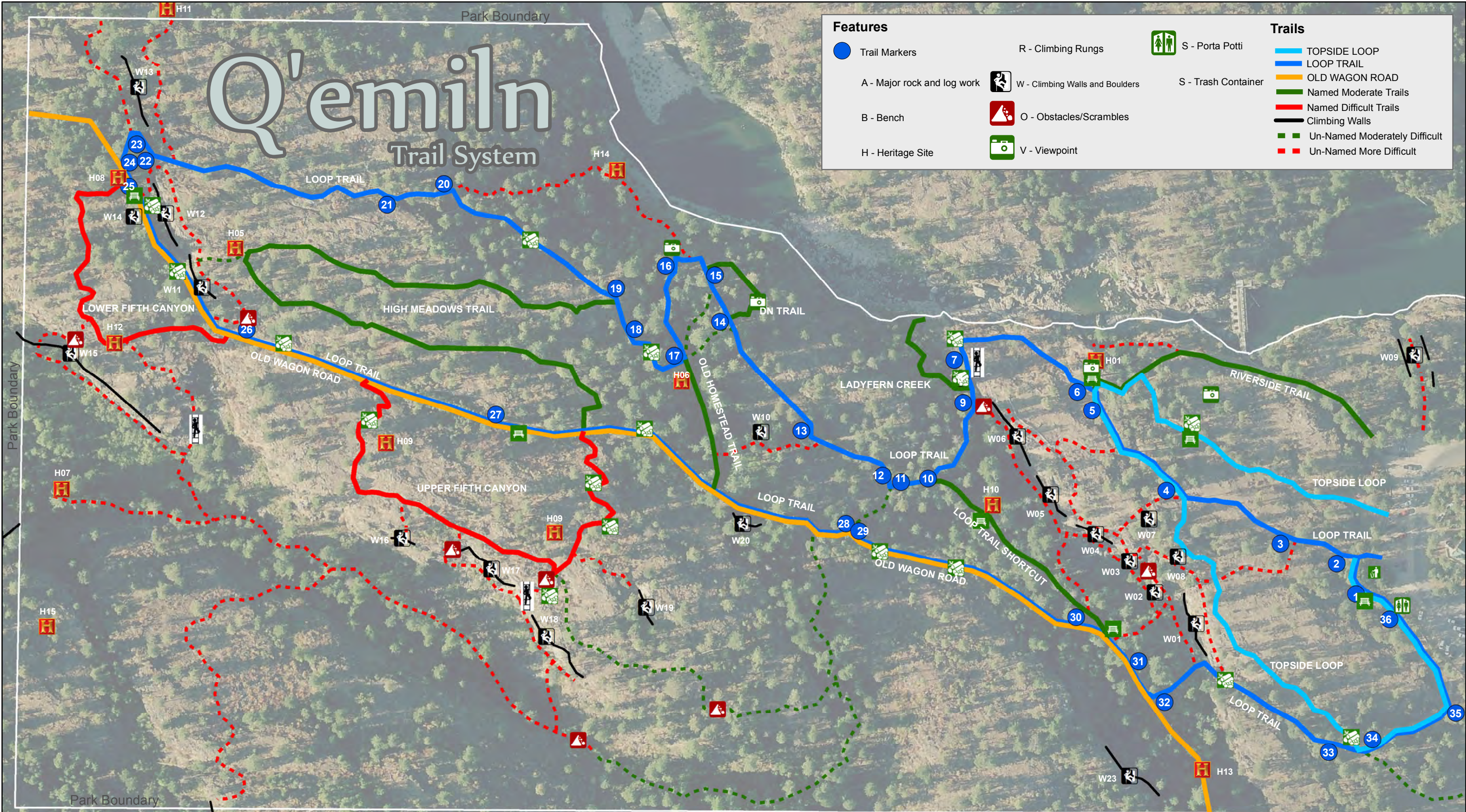
# Q'emiln Trail System

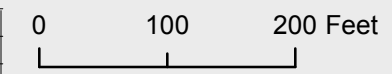


**Heritage Sites**

H05	Possible site of Diamond Dick's Mine	H12	The Lower 5th Canyon Loop Trail was named after W Clayton Miller, the US Deputy Surveyor who recorded Frederick Post's original Land Claim
H06	Lilac Homestead, Old Lilac tree	H13	The Old Wagon Road
H07	The Apple Orchard - Old homestead in Lower 5th Canyon, only access via climber trails	H14	The Fishing Hole beach, accessed by a short but steep spur trail - care needed on the last 50 feet!!
